- BID collections 2012 payments due March 1; reminder sent to members 2/23 and will continue through March. 2011 collection; brought in an estimated \$6,000 including almost \$2,000 in penalties

 After April 1 Administrator will no longer put allocated hours into collection. Administrator may put time into collection off the clock, Approved 100% of late fees received after April 1 will be paid to Administrator on a monthly basis. Motion: WW; Second: LF; All in Favor
 - Associate Member (AM) outreach very successful 10 new Associate members added in 2012 amounting to \$1,200 in revenue almost 4x goal; AM increased to 14 currently, from 4 in 2011 Approved Administrator bonus of \$100, and each new member brought in for the remainder of 2012 results in a \$40 per member bonus with a \$10 renewal bonus in 2013 through term of employment. Motion LR; Second: WW; All in Favor
- Administrator will build out project/task management tracking platform using cloud based application or alternative platform with broad access and increased functionality.
