- From COVID crisis to community Benefit Presentation
- Recommendation: implement time of day meter pricing, implement all week pricing, coordinate efforts with Lasalle Garage
- Exped \$12m revenue, generated 4m, parking meters were \$23M below what we were expecting to generate in a non COVID year
- Montclair Parking Garage: questions about all free Sunday parking, Truli that keeping the garage free is a good way to
  introduce people to a garage? Talk to Lucky's and Safeway if meters remain on Sunday because this will impact their parking
